542 Arthur fights his1<sup>st</sup> battle at <u>Darvel</u> in Ayrshire according to local legend (too late for 537 and too early for Artur MacAedan)

c545 Artur MacAedan born (this is a guesstimate)

563 Columba lands on Iona

565 Constantine lands at Govan

568 Columban monks invade Dunkeld (Arthur's 7th Battle in The Forest of Caledon?)

569 Britons battle Picts on Jura (Arthur's 8th Battle in Castello Guinnion?)

570 Arthur conducts Battle of Ardunnion (Ardinning) leading <u>Urien</u>, <u>Rhydderch Hael</u> and <u>Gwallawg</u> to victory over the Saxons Hussa and Ida (Arthur's 9<sup>th</sup> Battle close to the City of the Legion?)

573 Final Christian victory over Pagans at <u>Battle of Arderydd</u> or Arthuret (Arthur's 12<sup>th</sup> Battle?)

574 Aedan coronated King of Scots by Columba (1st time church is involved in Kingmaking)

575 Summit of Drumclett

580 Aedan battles Orkney

586 Death of Urien

590 Artur MacAedan dies in battle against the Maetae (according to Life of Columba)

597 Death of Columba

c600 First written mention of Arthur in Gododdin poem

602 Dunblane founded by Blaan (Artur's half-brother)

603 Battle of Degastan (led by Aedan)

607 Death of Aedan

664 Synod of Whitby

698 The Law of the Innocents

c700 Adomnan writes Life of Saint Columba mentioning Artur's death

828 Nennius writes History of the Britons listing Arthur's battles

848 Kenneth MacAlpin founds Alba

c900 Taliesin's poems mentioning Arthur et all (and Battle of Ardunnion)

927 England founded by Athelstan (Yes, Scotland is older!)
