Hello from Scotland

As we approach the second spring of The Clan Arthur Ancestral Lands Trust's inception, we are gathering pace towards our aim of securing a future home for Clan Arthur. We have been monitoring the property and land market surrounding Clan Arthur's ancestral lands on Loch Awe in Argyll, which is expensive and competitive, appealing mainly to cash buyers from the south east of England. The area we are focussing on is quite small with a limited number of properties and contains three large land owners identified so far. Two cottages have sold in the past year for over £300k and land plots fetch around £100k.

As I write, CAALT has raised an amazing total of $\pounds60,119.44$. This may appear to be far short of the amount we need to secure a land plot or property, but we are progressing very well. Our next funding target is $\pounds75,000$. If we achieve this, then we should qualify for our next instalment of \$25,000 (US) from our Clan benefactor, which would take our funding to around $\pounds95,000$; enough to consider securing a plot of land. We need **less than £15k** to do this and therefore a push to increase our fund raising this year is required. If you are considering giving a donation over the next few months, then you may wish to sponsor this fund-raising event . . .





Last year, Team Clan Arthur raised a magnificent £1,753 in sponsorship at the Glasgow Kiltwalk. We received an extra 50% top up of £877 from the Hunter Foundation, resulting in a total of £2,630 raised for the Clan Arthur Ancestral Lands Trust. So, we are doing it again this year, on Sunday 30th April, and we ask you once more to dig deep and sponsor us.

This year The Hunter Foundation <u>are not</u> adding the 50% top up, but we do have the benefit of 25% Gift Aid option from any UK tax payer who sponsors us, which was not available last year. So, if you live in the UK and sponsor us £1.00 with Gift Aid, then we should receive £1.25. If you live overseas and sponsor us \$1.00, then we shall receive \$1.00. I am sure that you will agree that this is a good opportunity to promote and fund-raise for CAALT.
